

ENGLISH

ADVENTURE STORIES:

The children will be exploring the genre of adventure stories and how they are different to other story genres. This involves the drama and climax created in an adventure story. We will be creating our own adventure stories with the same level of engagement for the reader as well as apply knowledge of fronted adverbials and complex sentences.

SHAPE POETRY:

The children will be exploring how poems can be written in a shape to portray their meaning. We will explore how language can be used for a specific effect and will be using this to write our own shape poems.

HISTORY

THE STONE AGE:

- Understand when the Stone Age was in British history.
- Understand what life was like in the Stone Age.
- Investigate how Stonehenge was built.
- Explore the reasons why Stonehenge was built.
- Identify continuity and changes throughout the Stone Age period.
