Umayyad period of rule

■ (661 - 750 CE)

- The Umayyad Caliphate was the second of the four major Islamic caliphates established after the death of Muhammad. This caliphate was entered on the Umayyad dynasty, hailing from Mecca.
- During Mu'awiya's reign (661–80), the seat of Islamic power was transferred from the Arabian Peninsula to Syria.
- Abu sufyan came from the Quraysh tribe.

Abbasid

- The Abbasid ruler was abas.
- The Abbasids appealed to non Arab Muslims.
- They ruled from 750 to 1258 AD making it one of the longest reign in the whole of Islamic history.

Baghdad in AD 900

- Baghdad was built in AD 752 by Caliph-Al-Mansur
- Baghdad [also known as the golden age] was the centre of learning.
- In about 964 AD Astronomy was created by Abd-al arahman Sufi.
- It ended in the year of 1258 AD.
