### **Ofsted Report**

We have now received the Ofsted report and we are pleased to share it with you. You can access it on our website at <http://primary.al-ashraf.org.uk>, where the link to the report will be available on the homepage.

The inspection was a no notice monitoring inspection which does not provide a grade for the regulations evaluated. Rather, its purpose is to inspect if previously unmet regulations were now being met. The school was inspected on the 'quality of education' and the 'effectiveness of leadership and management'. As with all inspections, safeguarding was also looked at as a standing agenda item.

**Alhumd, the school now meets all of the Independent Schools Standards.** The report recognises that the school is improving steadily. This is testament to the hard work and effort of all staff, pupils and the support of our parents.
